Priorities: For November 2017

- High visibility patrol in rural areas with visits to vulnerable residents.
- Continue to promote CSW (Speedwatch) and engage more members in the area.
- With the opening of several new schools we will be addressing inappropriate driving and parking around schools during the start and finish of the school day.

Update of actions and further activities being undertaken:

- Op Santa Shopwatch took place in and around Hay with safety advice offered to shops and shoppers.
- Reports have shown a reduced level of fraud over this Christmas so hopefully people are becoming more aware.
- Attendance was made at the light switch on in Hay and Talgarth, both were a fantastic success.

- Sadly 4 reports of police assaults were made last month luckily no officers were seriously injured.

Other issues of note:

130 service calls (which included 5 repeat calls), with time given to Missing vulnerable persons, Road traffic accidents, Suspicious incidents, intelligence gathering and incident investigation.
