- Continue to promote CSW (Speedwatch) and engage more members especially in the area of Talgarth school please contact helen.scott@dyfed-powys.pnn.police.uk if interested.
- Enforce the importance of safe driving, taking into consideration location and weather conditions especially with the forcasted wind and snow.

Update of actions and further activities being undertaken:

- Recent Roads Police checks have found several vehicles being driven without tax or insurance resulting in seizure and large fines.

- Please if you still have not joined up register on DPCM (Dyfed Powys Community Messaging) to receive important information soon after it happens; sign up at <u>www.dpcm.co.uk</u>.

- This month has highlighted several events including Sexual Violence Awareness week running 5th – 11th February remember #itsnotok. Also International Womens day was held against Female Genital Mutilation, a little talked about but very important procedure to be prevented.

Other issues of note:

114 service calls (which included 4 repeat calls), with time given to Missing vulnerable persons, Road traffic accidents, Suspicious incidents, intelligence gathering and incident investigation.
