Small Grants Guidance

Introduction

Gwernyfed Community Council offers small grants to support **local charities, social enterprises, and community organisations** that contribute to the well-being of the Gwernyfed ward. Grants may be used for projects, events, and improvements that benefit local residents.

Application Process

- Applications can be submitted in two ways:
 - Filling in the current form on paper
 - o Coming soon: Online Forms

Who Can Apply?

Eligible applicants must:

- **☑** Be a **registered or non-registered charity, social enterprise, or community group** based in the Gwernyfed ward.
- Have a bank account with at least two unrelated signatories.
- Have a constitution.
- Have **less than 12 months' running costs in unrestricted reserves** (unless approved for a specific project).

X Not eligible for funding:

- Political groups or activities.
- Religious organisations (unless funding is for a **community-focused** project).
- General fundraising appeals.
- Projects located outside the Gwernyfed ward.

What We Fund

We support projects that benefit the local community, including:

- **Capital Costs** Repairs, renovations, and improvements to community buildings (e.g., village halls, chapels, play parks, public toilets).
- ✓ **Project Costs** One-off community activities, environmental projects, or cultural initiatives.
- **Equipment** Items essential for project delivery (e.g., sports equipment, gardening tools for biodiversity projects).
- Running Costs we will fund a (?)% of running costs for an organisation

♠ We do NOT fund:

- Salaries or long-term operational costs (unless exceptional circumstances apply).
- Core school expenditure (e.g., staffing, curriculum delivery, routine maintenance).
- Projects taking place more than six months after the grant is awarded.

Application Deadlines & Review Process

- **Applications are accepted throughout the year** and reviewed at **Council Meetings (held** 10 times per year).
- **Final deadline: 31st October** (applications after this may be delayed until April).
- IIII Grants are paid after the precept is received from Powys County Council (by 30th April).
- **Processing Time:** Applicants will be notified within **4 weeks** of submission.

How to Apply

- ★ Complete the application
- 🖈 Submit applications at least two weeks before a Council Meeting

Required Documents:

- Latest income & expenditure accounts
- Balance sheet
- Copy of constitution (for first-time applicants)

Reporting & Accountability

- Over £1,000? You must submit a Project Completion Report within 12 months.
- Unused funds? The council may request repayment.
- **Publicity:** Recipients must acknowledge Gwernyfed Community Council's support in materials and reports.

How We Score Applications

Applications are assessed based on:

- ✓ Community Benefit Number of residents who will benefit.
- ✓ **Sustainability** Long-term impact of the project.
- ✓ Financial Need The organisation's ability to fund the project without assistance.
- ✓ **Feasibility** Realistic implementation and completion.
- ✓ **Funding Mix** Efforts to secure co-funding from other sources.
